3. Manner of Submission of Tender:

The tenders to be submitted in two separate Sealed Envelopes as below: -

3.1. Envelope No.1

The first envelope clearly marked, as 'Envelope No.1' shall contain the following Documents.

- a) Copy of Deposit receipt/Swift copy for the said amount as Earnest moneydeposit (EMD). No cheques shall be accepted.
- **b)** Performance certificates & work orders of execution of similar type of Interior furnishing & Electrification works as follows:

Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 5 years ending last day of monthprevious to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:

Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost

Or

Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost

Or

One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.

- **c)** Valid and certified copy of following documents shall be enclosed without which the Tender shall be out-rightly rejected:
- i) Copy of Certificate of Registration/Incorporation of Business Name
- ii) Copy of certificate of registration by Contractor's Registration Body (CRB) as a Building Works Contractor
- iii) Copy of valid business license from Authority
- iv) Copy of Valid Tax Clearance Certificate from the tender opening date
- v) Dully signed Power of attorney
- vi) Self-declaration on Company's letter heads that bidder is not blacklisted/debarred by any Government at the time of bidding
- vii) Sworn Affidavit/undertaking indicating that at the time of bidding, the bidder has no any pending litigation or any legal dispute in the last two (2) years before any court of law.
- viii) Qualification and Experience of Technical Staffs in the company relevant to the building construction industry.
- ix) List of at least five (5) clients with references to which the company has undertaken building construction, Remodeling, Refurbishment, Renovation and Office Partitioning for Government or Institutions or Banks each valued at a minimum of TZS. 200,000,000 and above in the last 5 years.
- x) Financial Statements for the last two (2) consecutive years (2022 and 2023) certified by an auditor.

- xi) List of key equipment
- xii) Experience Certificate/ Performance certificates & work orders for similar type of works shall be enclosed by the contractor in the first envelope only without which the tender shall be outrightly rejected.
- xiii) Copies of NIDA card as Applicable shall be enclosed.
 - **d)**Technically Qualified Engineer/ Supervisor should be available @ site who has understanding of the drawings and execution of works. His name along with his qualification and Consent letter should be enclosed in envelope No. 1 who shall be available @ site during the progress of work.
 - e) The Tenderer with whom, Memorandum of Understanding for electrical works is made must hold valid electrical license from the applicable Competent Government Authority who shall carry out the electrification works. Hence, applicable Electrical License/ Registration from competent authority is to be enclosed with notarized Memorandum of Understanding without which Tender will not be considered and shall be outrightly rejected.
 - **f)** The tenderer shall submit notarized memorandum of understanding for Air conditioning works as per format.
 - **g)** An undertaking on is to be enclosed stating that I/we/Firm has not been black-listed in any of the financial institutions/Banks & not found guilty of any misconduct.
 - h)IMPORTANT NOTE: if at the time of verification of document, it is found that documents enclosed are not in order, the tender is liable to be outrightly rejected

3.2 Envelope No.2

The second envelope clearly marked, as 'Envelope No.2' shall contain only the completed Tender document/ price bid along with the drawings and details issued with the blank tender forms duly signed bythe Contractor should be enclosed.

If the Bank is satisfied with papers enclosed in the first envelope, then only the Envelope No. 2 shall be Opened.

<u>NOTE:</u>- The Tenders are to be submitted in Two separate sealed envelopes i.e Technical Bid-Envelope No.1 & Price Bid Envelope No.2 as mentioned above, and the two separate sealed envelopes are to be <u>put in one common sealed cover</u>, the contractor shall mention over the commonsealed cover that envelope no. 1 & envelope no.2 are inside the common sealed cover. While openingif it is found that the two separate sealed envelopes are not inside the common sealed cover the tender shall be outrightly rejected.

4. GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- a) The work defined in the schedule is for <u>Interior furnishing</u>, <u>Electrification & Airconditioningwork</u> for Bank's proposed <u>Upanga Branch</u>.
- **b)** Every page of Tender Document shall be Signed by the Contractor with full dated Signature and Seal.
- c) Contractor has to quote his rate both in figures and words.
- **d)** The entire work is to be finished within <u>60 days</u>. It is expected that the contractor shall carry out the work at site.
- **e)** The Defect Liability Period of the work shall be Twelve months from the Date of virtual completion Certificate issued by the Architect of the Bank.
- f) Only two interim payments shall be paid to the contractor till the completion of contract. The maximum cumulative amount of the all-interim bills shall be 50 % of the Tendered Amount. From the interim bill an amount of 10% of tendered amount will be deducted towards retention amount inclusive of initial Security deposit & Earnest money deposit. The final bills shall be scrutinized within 15 days from the Date of completion, and the period of honoring the same shall be One month. Half of the retention amount i.e. 5% of the work shall be paid with the final Bill. The final 5% retention amount of the work will be kept as Security deposit and will be released only after Six months from the date of virtual completion of work as certified by the Bank's Architect along with EMD amount. The retention amount shall carry no interest whatsoever.
- **g)** The contractor/s shall not be paid any advance payments.
- h) While working at the site, contractor shall make his own arrangements for the storage of materials from the point of damage and security. Similarly, he shall be responsible for the preservation and maintenance of the premises.
- i) Before commencing the work, the contractor shall mark the layout to full size and get same approved from Architect.
- j) The tender shall remain valid for 90 days.
- **k)** The contractors shall quote the individual rates excluding taxes.
- I) MANDATORY TAXES
 - VAT & any other applicable taxes to be deducted at source shall be deducted from the Bill of Contractor as per the Standard norms of Government.
- **m)** Payment of Electricity charges at the Site for execution of work shall be payable by Contractor only.

5. SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT: -

- a) A set of drawings is being issued along with the tender and the set contains preliminary layout planof the interiors, and electrification works preliminary typical details of various items. The Admin Officer of the Bank may be contacted for this purpose. The entire set is to be returned along with the tender bid with full dated signature of the Tenderer in a separate envelope.
- b) The tender is to be properly filled and endorsed and to be quoted in full.
- c) The contractor should quote in figures as well as in words the rate and amount tendered by them. The amount for each item should be worked out and the requisite totals given.
- d) The contractors shall quote the exact working rates of items & no rebate / discount in percentages shall be considered as it is an item rate tender with the price bid, the rates quoted will only be taken into account. however, during the period of negotiation if any as the authorities may deem fit to shall be considered during the process of negotiations while acceptance of the tender.
- e) The rates to be quoted are on item rate basis and are to be <u>inclusive</u> of everything <u>including</u> all thetaxes involved viz octroi if any, sales tax, works contract tax, excise duty, material cost, labour, etc.complete but Excluding Taxes, which shall be paid extra on overall actual Bill Amount
- **f)** Blank Tender forms shall be available at the Web Site of Bank of Baroda, (www.bankofbaroda.co.tz) under section Tenders.
- g) Earnest Money and Security Deposit

An amount of TZS 65.00 Mn/- (TZS Sixty Five million only) shall be paid by depositing the amount in bank's account as mentioned above as Earnest Money Deposit at the time of tendering. No interest is liable to be paid by the Bank on the above deposits.

- h) Tender's acceptance:
- i) The Bank reserves the right to accept / reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons for rejection/acceptance whatsoever.
- j) The tenderer whose tender is accepted will have to enter in to an agreement immediately on being informed to do so. In case of failure on the part of tenderer to sign the agreement within the stipulated time, the earnest money paid by him shall stand forfeited to bank and the offer of the tenderer shall be considered as withdrawn by him.

k) Premises:

- k.1) The work is to be carried out in the proposed Branch Premises & the time period provided for completion of work is inclusive of load shedding hours & aforesaid constraints. The contractor should make his own alternative arrangements at his own cost to compensate with load shedding hours & no additional remuneration shall be paid for such arrangements nor any additional time will be granted on these accounts.
- k.2) The tenderer shall be presumed to have carefully examined the drawings, conditions and specifications of the work and have fully acquainted themselves with all details of the site and with all the necessary information and data pertaining to the work prior to tendering for the work.

- i) The tenderer may in the forwarding letter mention any points he may wish to make clear but right is reserved to reject the same or the whole of the tenders if the same becomes conditional tender thereby.
- **j)** All pages of document, conditions, specifications, drawings and plans etc. shall be signed by the tenderer. The tender should bear full signature of the tenderer.
- **k)** The Managing Director of the Bank or his duly authorized Officer shall open the tenders. In the event of a tender being rejected the Bank shall refund the amount of earnest money deposited to the tenderer, on his giving a receiptfor the return of money.
- I) The drawings, plans, details and the Specifications are only indicative and the schedule of quantities are only tentative. Any changes/additions/deletions/alterations in them shall be accommodated while executing the work without any prejudice. Any extra items or variations upon the schedule items shall be scrutinized by the Architect of the Bank and his decision shall be final and binding in all respects.
- **m)** Specifications of various materials and quality of work shall be the essence of the contract along with the time period and these shall be strictly adhered to.
- n) LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:
 - LIQUIDATED DAMAGES @ TZS 1.00 Mn/- (TZS 1.00 Mn Only) per day shallbe charged for any delay in the completion of the work beyond the stipulated time and this clause shall be strictly followed.
- **o)** Extra items, if any shall be paid on the basis of cost of materials (inclusive of all the Taxes as already mentioned) and labour plus 10% towards overheads and profits and items rates already accepted shall formthe basis of this Contract.
- p) The Bank Authorities at their discretion may delete any part of item or item in full as they may feel necessary during the course of execution and no compensation will be paid /claimed in this regard. The contractor shall not claim any compensation towards such items.
- **q)** The Bank Authorities reserve the right to introduce or delete any part of item or items in full or at its discretion/change/modify the dates of submission/opening of tenders by issuing a corrigendum in respect of the particular tender.
- r) The work shall be executed by the Contractor at his own risk and responsibility and the Bank shall not be held liable for any accidents/unforeseen events directly/indirectly and the Contractor understands clearly that no claim for any accidents or loss of life whatsoever shall be entertained by the Bank.

- (i) The contractors shall quote the exact working rates of items & no rebate /discount in percentages shall be considered as it is an item rate tender with the price bid, the rates quoted will only be taken into account. however, during the period of negotiation if any as the authorities may deem fit to shall be considered during the process of negotiations while acceptance of the tender.
- (ii) The officers/ manager/ executive tables and front row countertables/ cash counter shall not have any joint in working top/ side verticals/ front apron; if any joint is found during inspection the same shall be rejected. the vendors/ contractors are advised not to fix any finishing laminates till the inspection of bank's architect.
- (iii) The contractors shall quote the individual rates excluding taxes.
